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

Initially given remotely via MS Teams in small gatherings during the pandemic. Hands on.Later also face 2 face



- How to implement in your course





## **Homework assignment**

Participants had to prepare a short script and a recording and send it a week before the workshop

Leonie uses music in her introduction and explains what the listener can expect from this episode school psychology regarding developmental dyslexia

- In the first part of the podcast, she lets the listener know how the podcast is structured.
- First the highlights of what dyslexia is and then that she will bring in a guest in the second part. It's a nice way of letting the listener know what is coming.

Kim does a walking interview with a minor -

- She is good at informing the listener of where she is and updates them if there are any changes so there are no sound surprises.
- The summary or additions at the end are a nice touch to add more context to the podcast.
